- Enter Email address & Dassword
- 3. Click on "SUBMIT" Button: ( A helpdesk email from IEEE will be send to the corresponding email)
- 4. Account Activation: Go to your email and please click on URL "Click for account activation". (Email Addressed will be verified)
- 5. Login to your New IEEE PDF Express Account using login credentials
- 6. Fill the IEEE PDF eXpress User profile: Personal information and Submit; Click ok
- --- Existing users of PDF eXpress skip the above steps, you can enter the existing credentials which created previously, Verify that your contact information is valid and proceed the following:
- 7. Before uploading the paper into the portal, kindly ensure the following:

- 10. After "File has been converted successfully", download the PDF from the "Action" Tab in the Dashboard.
- 11. Rename the downloaded PDF as per the file name: INDICON\_PAPERID (Ex: for the paper id 50, the pdf file name is "INDICON\_50").
- 12. Kindly submit the downloaded Camera Ready Paper in the Microsoft CMT by clicking on "Create Camera Ready Submission" respectively under the "Actions" column.

- Include good quality figures/graphics,
- Tables must be drawn in a table format, not as an image.
- Text description and callouts for all the figure numbers, table numbers, and equation numbers must be present in the paper as per the order of their occurrence.
- Reference not to be cited in the Abstract and Conclusion part.
- Ensures a minimum of 5 pages and 10 quality references
- \* Incorporate the suggestions recommended by the reviewers.
